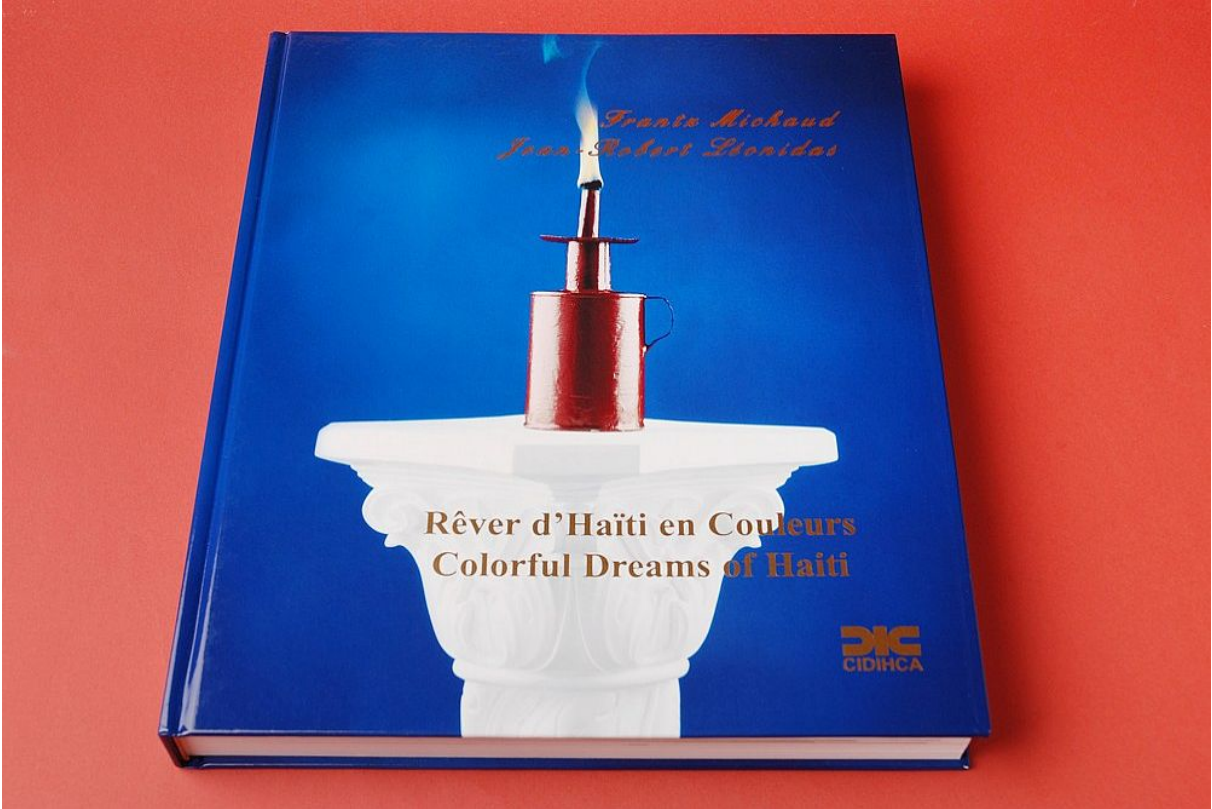


**Frantz Michaud, Jean-Robert Léonidas:
